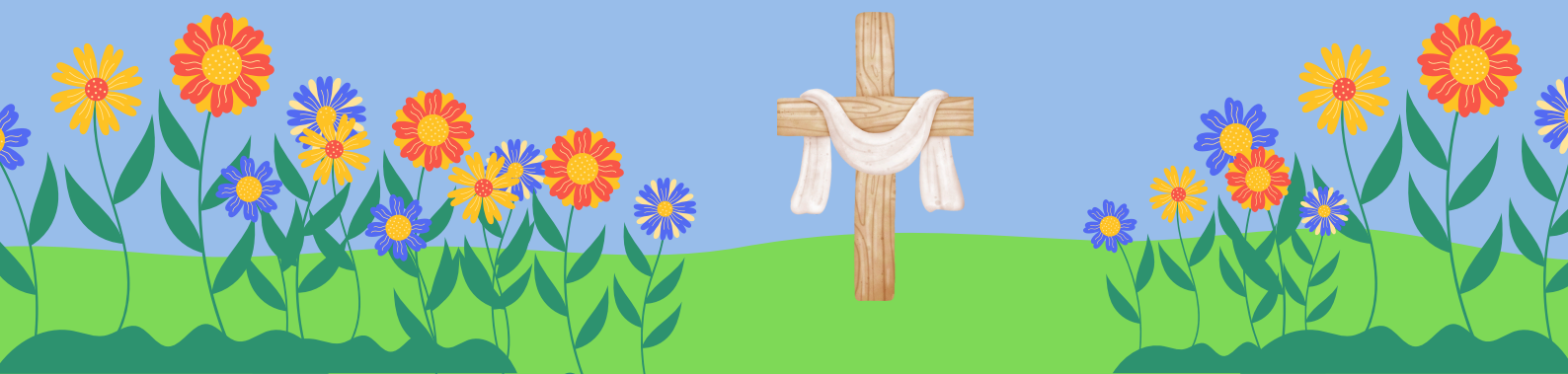
The Common Good

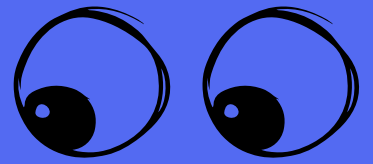
