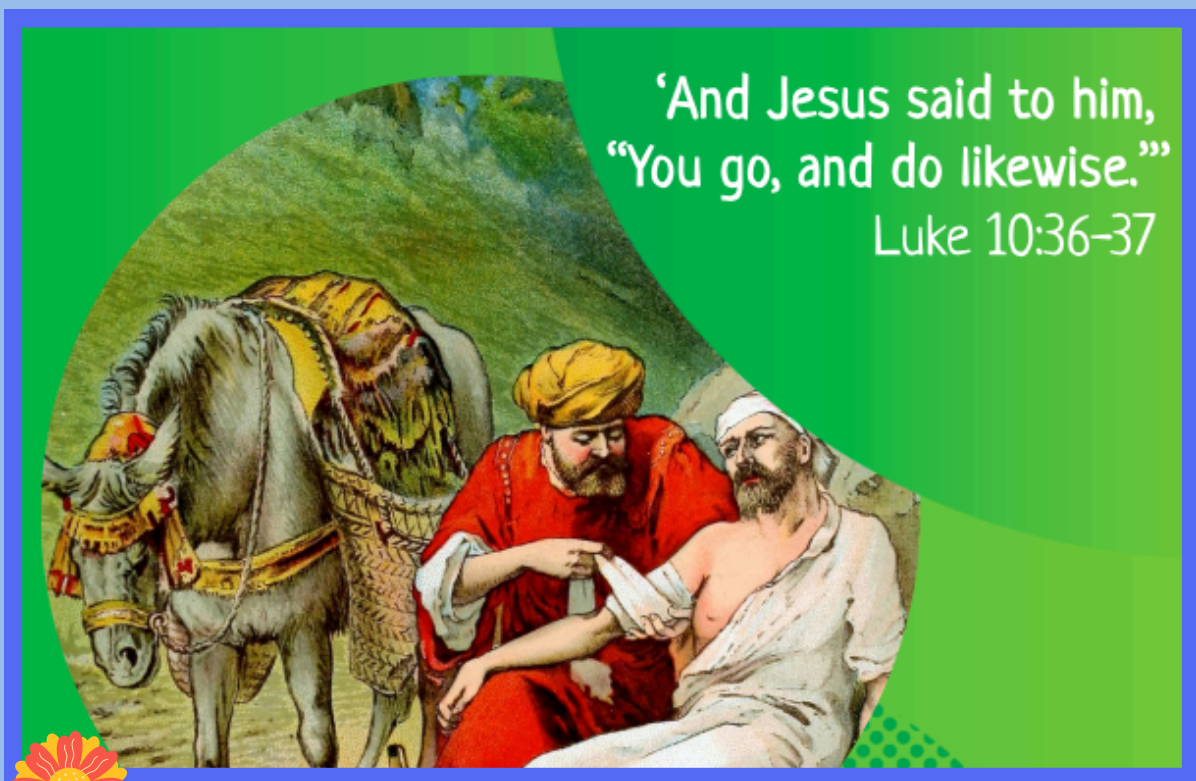


Our Lady's Mission Statement

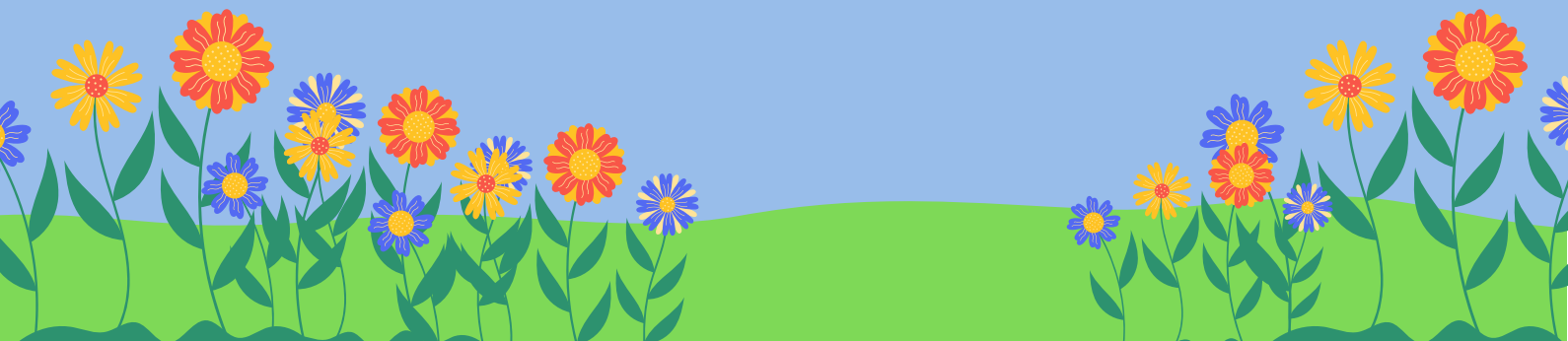

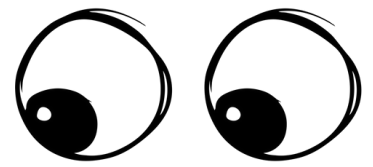
Recognition Awards
