Our Lady's Mission Statement

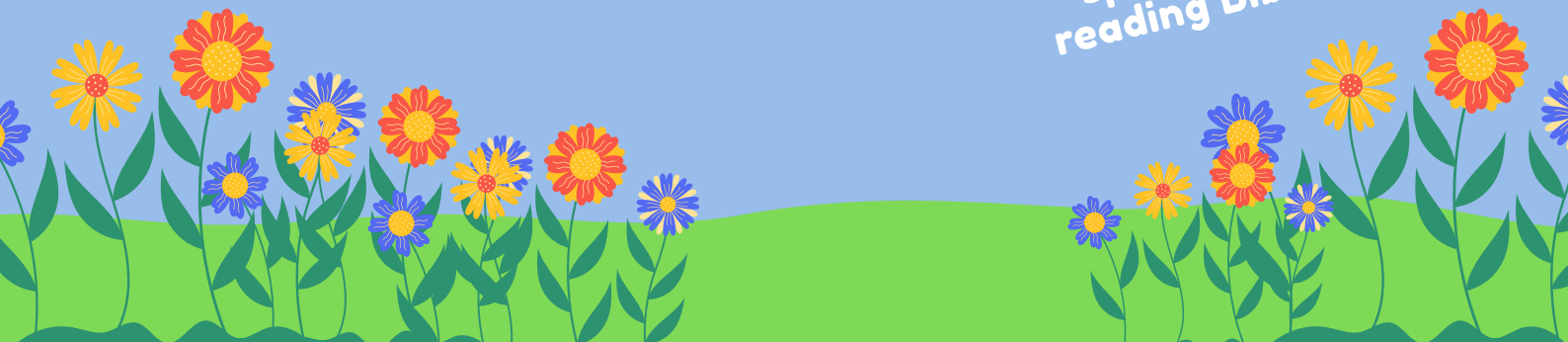
As our lady instructed, we are called to follow His word (John 2:5) - learning with love, joy and hope.

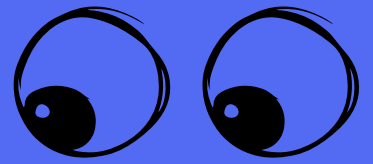
